

**Covid-19 Guidelines for Camp**  
**Updated January 25, 2021**

It is very important that we provide a safe environment for our campers and staff this coming summer. The guidelines that will be in place for the upcoming summer camp will be decided in mid-May. While protocols may be different this summer from what they are today, campers and parents should expect the following:

- We will follow all protocols and procedures that are in place for the State of Ohio, Wood County, and Bowling Green State University that are in place at the time of camp.
- Group size will be kept to no more than 40 participants
- We will assign a set staff to each group off the ice and limit any additional staff while on the ice.
- Expect to check in by groups on Sunday.
- We will avoid having the entire camp together at the same time.
- We will spend as much time outdoors, weather permitting
- Masks will most likely be worn at all times when off the ice
- You will have the option to have a single room
- Appropriate physical distancing in locker room
- We will allow personal electronic devices, that were discouraged in the past.
  - There may not be a group movie in the evening, campers will be allowed to stream a movie or tv show in their room before they go to bed.
